LTAP Training

- Online training opportunities through other agencies (LTAP, FHWA, etc.) are updated regularly
 - Nationwide upcoming training webinars
 - 24/7 on-demand virtual trainings
 - technology tutorials
- Kansas Roads Scholar Committee virtual meeting – Aug. 5
 - Will move towards a competency based approach
 - Allows for greater quality and flexibility, especially in a virtual training environment
 - Moving at least six classes online this fall
 - Working with instructors to either move classes online or audit pre-existing virtual classes as a possibility to satisfy Roads Scholar requirements
 - No in-person classes until at least Oct.
 - Will have fall training plan by Mid-Sept.
- KS LTAP Virtual Leadership Course
 - Scheduled for Aug. 18 and Aug. 20
 - Full course is split across four sessions
 - 2 hours in the morning, 2 in the afternoon, across 2 days
 - Offering as a free training during COVID when leaders are needed most
- In the process of planning a training overhaul. Changes will include: consistent branding across all classes, defined learning objectives, knowledge checks for each class to demonstrate competency, increased interaction, and adherence with adult learning principles. Hoping to have changes completed for 2021 training season.
